Why read over summer?

Research shows that reading ability can decline during the summer break. We believe it is important to keep the momentum going and establish the reading habit.

We have decided to allow the school library books to be borrowed over the summer period to those students who are returning in 2015.

How to borrow books over the summer

Parents must sign the form on this pamphlet agreeing that their child will be returning to Logan Park High School in 2015 and that books will be returned during the first week of school 2015.

Once this form is signed students can borrow books any time that the library is open. After sitting an exam might be a good time to pop in and make a selection.

Students who have returned all outstanding library books will be eligible for summer holiday borrowing.
